PETITION FOR REVOCATION

Comes the State of Arkansas by, Jeff Phillips Prosecuting Attorney for the Fifth Judicial District, and for its Petition for Revocation states:

1. This Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this action and the parties, and venue is proper.
2. On 10/26/2021, defendant was convicted of the crime of 'DOMESTIC BATTERING IN THE SECOND DEGREE (8/12/2005 AND THEREAFTER)' and ENDANGERING WELFARE OF MINOR - I (8/12/2005 AND THEREAFTER) and was sentenced to:

X	Penitentiary for months; Probation for 60 months; Suspended imposition of sentence of months; Fines, costs and restitution to the Sheriff.

A copy of the Sentencing Order can be found in the court file.

3. The order of probation was conditioned upon the following:
 - a) Defendant shall live a law-abiding life, be of good behavior and not violate any Federal, State, or Municipal law.
 - b) Shall not use or possess alcoholic beverages, marijuana, narcotics, or any illegal drug or controlled substance, or associate with those who do.
 - c) Shall not associate with persons known to have committed a crime or is encouraging someone to commit a crime.
 - d) Shall obtain permission from the Probation Officer to travel outside the state of Arkansas.
 - e) Shall not own, use, or have possession of any firearm.
 - f) Shall notify the Probation Officer and County Sheriff of any change in address within 12 Hours of moving.
 - g) Shall notify the Probation Officer at such times and places as he/she shall

direct and comply with other requests made by the Probation Officer.

- h) Pay fines, Court Costs, and restitution to the Sheriff.
- 4. That Defendant is financially able to comply with the aforesaid order.
- 5. The Defendant has failed to comply with the above conditions in that:
 - a) The Defendant has failed to live a law-abiding life, to wit: The Defendant has committed new criminal conduct of Rape in Pope County, Arkansas, on or around May 14, 2022.

The State of Arkansas requests that a bench warrant be issued for Defendant's arrest and that she/he be held until such time as a hearing can be held to determine if Defendant's probation should be revoked pursuant to A.C.A. 16-93-308, and for all other proper relief.
